


The Learning Space exists outside of a single Blackboard course – and even outside of Blackboard – where you can link to content from any of your courses. You can even invite someone from outside the Blackboard environment to see – and interact – with this content via email.

1. From the My Institution tab, click **Campus Pack**.

Here is a sample of how the Learning Space can look:






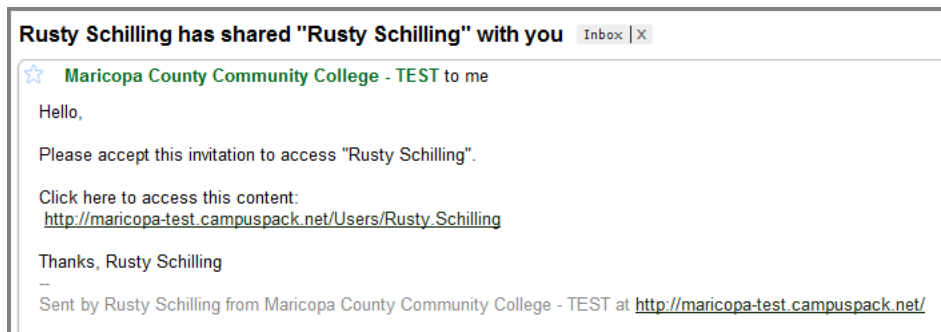
The interface also includes a search bar, a 'Go' button, and a 'Help' menu.


To invite someone from outside the Blackboard environment:

1. Click **Permissions**.
2. The Viewer tab is selected, which allows the person to view and comment on content.

3. Click the  button.
4. Enter the person's email address, then click the  button.

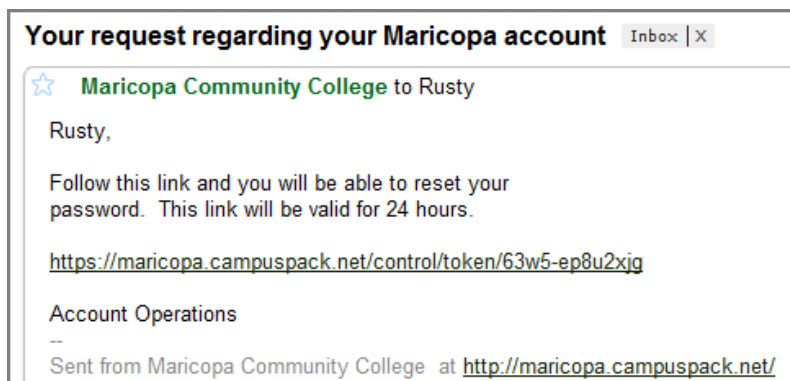
Here's a sample email message which will appear for the invitee:



 It's possible to set up an account for a non-Blackboard user to not only view and comment on content, but to also create his/her own.

To access your Learning Space outside of Blackboard for the first time:

1. From your browser, enter this URL: <http://maricopa.campuspack.net/> .
2. Click **Log In**.
3. Click **Forgotten Username/Password**.
4. Enter your Blackboard username (MEID) and click **Submit**. An email will be sent to you, indicating how to set your password. Click **OK**.



5. In your email program, open the email and click the link.
6. In the Reset Password or Login page, enter a password and click **Submit**. The Home page for your learning space appears, listing your Blackboard course memberships and content shared with you.
7. If you add content from here (e.g., blogs, wikis), then it will also appear in Blackboard, using the Campus Pack link in you're My Institution tab.
